School fees explained

Wherever possible we endeavour to present our fees in a manner that allows a comprehensive view of the total outlay for your daughter's schooling. The fully inclusive fee includes school board registration, year level camps, most excursions, subject fees, school magazine, competition fees, student accident insurance and all compulsory sport. Boarding fees include airport transfers and most weekend activities. On occasions there will be charges for activities e.g. use of taxis and specialist coaching.

Enrolment Fees

On application for and confirmation of the enrolment, two types of fees apply:

- ◆ Application Fee A\$50 non-refundable per student, is payable when a completed Enrolment Application is submitted. This is to cover administration and registration costs.
- ◆ Enrolment Special Deposit – A\$500 for a Day Student or A\$1000 for a Boarding Student. The Enrolment Special Deposit is a refundable fee payable per family, when you accept the place offered to your daughter, and refunded when she completes her schooling at Glennie and all accounts have been finalised.

Discounts

Sibling discounts apply to current students from fully inclusive tuition and boarding fees as follows;

- ◆ 5% for the first sister
- ◆ 10% for the subsequent sisters

Building, Scholarship and Library Fund

Voluntary donations to the above support the further development of the school infrastructure, library resources and support bursaries. A suggested donation of \$150 is noted on the fee statements. Payment is voluntary and tax deductible.

Fee Payment

Fees are payable at the beginning of each term unless a fixed payment schedule is in place to pay fees by the end of term. Full term fees are payable for students attending more than half a term. Payment may be made by:

- ◆ B-Pay and EFTPOS from either savings or cheque account (preferred) or credit card accounts.
- ◆ Cash or Cheque (made payable to The Glennie School).
- ◆ Mastercard, VISA and American Express



- ◆ The School charges 1% merchant fee on "premium"/overseas card payments.
- ◆ Bank transfers.
- ◆ Online payments from the school website.
- ◆ If fees remain outstanding, or a school approved payment schedule is not in place 30 days after the due date, administration fees of up to \$500 per term will be automatically charged on that balance.
