Boarding

- ◆ Air-conditioned accommodation

- ◆ Residential and supervisory staff services
- ◆ Some academic tutoring
- ◆ Many weekend activities

There will be some items that arise as a 'once off' activity or service, which may be charged to your fee account or separately depending on the type of service or activity. These would be notified to you well in advance and are usually in the Elective category.



Items not included

These are EXTRA charges and generally relate to the choice of an additional service / activity, e.g.

- ◆ Musical instrument tutoring
- ◆ Singing / speech tutoring
- ◆ Portrait, tutor and family photo
- ◆ Personal use of taxis
- ◆ Some secondary and boarding excursions / activities
- ◆ Tennis / gymnastics coaching
- ◆ Tours & Camps (e.g. French Immersion, Music, Sport)
- ◆ Club G team and Recreational Sport activities
- ◆ Some materials and consumables (e.g. hospitality)
- ◆ Computer printing in excess of allocation
- ◆ Student photocopying costs
- ◆ Uniforms, book hire and stationery (Glennie One Stop Shop)
- ◆ Boarder toiletries / incidentals
- ◆ Doctor and dentist visits and pharmaceutical supplies
- ◆ Dry cleaning for boarders' uniforms
- ◆ Additional private tutoring
- ◆ Medical insurance

- ◆ All fees are in Australian Dollars (A\$) and subject to annual review
- ◆ Purchase of the Notebook Computer is strongly recommended for new students

Enrolment Fees

On application for and confirmation of the enrolment, two types of fees apply:

- ◆ Application Fee of \$50 (non-refundable) is payable at the time of submitting a completed Enrolment Application Form or forms. This fee covers registration and administration costs
- ◆ Enrolment Confirmation Fee - \$500 (non-refundable) is payable at the time of acceptance of a place offered by the Principal

Notice of cancellation

Parents are required to provide a term's notice when withdrawing a student prior to the end of Year 12. In lieu of this, a term's fees will be payable.

Discounts

Sibling discounts apply to current students from fully inclusive tuition and boarding fees as follows:

- ◆ 5% for the first sister
- ◆ 10% for subsequent sisters

Building, Scholarship and Library Fund

Voluntary donations to the above support the further development of the school infrastructure, library resources and support bursaries. A suggested donation of \$150 is noted on the fee statements. Payment is voluntary and tax deductible.

Fee Payment

Fees must be paid prior to the beginning of each semester. Students attending for less than one term will be charged the equivalent of one term's fees. Payment may be made by:

- ◆ B-Pay and EFTPOS from either savings or cheque account (preferred) or credit card accounts
- ◆ Cash or Cheque (made payable to The Glennie School)
- ◆ Mastercard, VISA and American Express



- ◆ The School charges 1% merchant fee on "premium"/overseas card payments
- ◆ Bank transfers
- ◆ Online payments from the school website
- ◆ Please be aware that if fees are not paid prior to the start of term, the enrolment may be cancelled by the Principal
